Use Verdana font with 1.15 line spacing.

#### 1. Title – 16 pt, centered

Title of the presentation.

#### 2. Authors – 11 pt, centered

The presenting Author should be underlined.

The corresponding Author should be marked with the star.

John Doe<sup>1\*</sup>, Mary Smith<sup>2</sup>

#### 3. Affiliation – 9 pt

Provide the name of your University and faculty with the full address.

University of City, Faculty of Chemistry, New Street 2, 45555 City, Country

#### 4. E-mail address – 9 pt

E-mail address to whom the correspondence should be directed.

#### 5. Abstract – 10 pt

0.5 cm indentation for the second and subsequent paragraphs.

#### 6. Keywords – 10 pt

Name 3-7 keywords associated with your presentation.

**Keywords:** electrochemistry, chemometrics, pharmaceuticals, spectroscopy

#### 7. Acknowledgements – 10 pt

List all the financial support and those individuals who provided help during the research.

#### 8. References – 10 pt

Please follow the style of citing articles in journals and books given in the abstract template.

Do not use the autonumeration option.
