CLIMATE

Typical local climate is moderate, transient, characterized by frequent changes of weather, because over the Poland clash dry air masses from the Eurasian continent and moist air from the Atlantic. The climate is also influenced by the very advantageous geographical location of Krakow - in a valley between the Karpaty and the upland areas and in the valley of the Wisla river. This causes the frequent occurrence of fog (about 60 days a year) and large changes in atmospheric pressure.

The average year temperature is $8 - 9^{\circ}$ C. The lowest indications of thermometers usually appear from mid-January to mid-February (the average January temperature is app. -3°C). The warmest and most sunny months of the year are July and August (average July temperature is app. -18°C).







Krakows' climate characterized by relatively high humidity reaching 85% in winter. Annual average rainfall varies between 650 and 700 mm with a maximum in July and minimum in September. Snowfall can be expected since the end of October. May persist until mid-March, although this period is shortened in recent years, and winters are becoming milder.

CURRENCY

Official currency in Poland is the ZŁOTY (PLN). In relation to other currencies of its value is as follows:

1 USD (American Dollar) - about 3,00 - 3,30 PLN

1 EUR (EURO) - about 4,00 -4.30 PLN




Apart from 20 dormitories offering accommodation for nearly 9,000 people, on the grounds of the Campus there are: students' clubs, football pitches, billiards club, tennis courts, supermarket, fitness club, post office, bank and kindergarten. All dormitories have rooms for 2 and 3-bed. They are fully furnished (beds, blankets, bed linen, bathroom, kitchen). During the academic year on campus, live students in almost from all of the universities of Krakow. An undoubted advantage of this place is its location and proximity to educational facilities. Student houses are equipped with fast internet network to which access is free For each of the rooms is supplied signal cable television. In addition, telephone exchanges in the dorms allow free calling between the inhabitants of the dormitories and the AGH-UST.
